AGREED ORDER  
TO HOLD MATTER IN ABEYANCE

The Respondent, Chad Albert Buckley, having requested the Executive Branch Ethics Commission (“Commission”) to hold the above-styled matter in abeyance pending the resolution of the criminal proceeding styled *The Commonwealth of Kentucky v. Chad Albert Buckley*, Fayette Circuit Court, Criminal Branch, 8<sup>th</sup> Division, Indictment No.: 14-CR-1127, to preserve the Respondent’s constitutional guarantees afforded to the Respondent by the Fifth Amendment to the United States Constitution; the Respondent or his counsel, if one should be procured, having agreed to keep the counsel for the Complainant well-advised as to the status of any resolutions of the criminal matter in circuit court; the parties having agreed to hold this matter in abeyance until the Respondent shall enter a guilty plea or his criminal matter is otherwise adjudicated in circuit court; the Commission having reviewed the record and being otherwise sufficiently advised;

WHEREFORE the Commission holds the following:

1. The above-styled matter shall be held in abeyance until the Respondent shall enter a guilty plea the matter of *The Commonwealth of Kentucky v. Chad Albert Buckley*, Fayette Circuit Court, Criminal Branch, 8<sup>th</sup> Division, Indictment No.: 14-CR-1127, or his criminal matter is otherwise adjudicated in circuit court.

2. The Respondent or his counsel, if one should be procured, will keep the counsel for the Complainant well advised as to the status of the criminal matter in Circuit Court so that this matter may resume as soon as possible after the criminal matter is resolved at the circuit court level.




