

SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

This agreement made and entered into between the Executive Branch Ethics Commission (hereinafter the “Commission”) and Liberty Campbell.

WHEREAS, this agreement involves the matter styled *Executive Branch Ethics Commission v. Liberty Campbell*, Case No. 14-022;

WHEREAS, the Commission is designated by statute as the agency responsible for enforcing the Executive Branch Code of Ethics, KRS Chapter 11A;

WHEREAS, on September 15, 2014, the Commission alleged facts in an Initiating Order that Liberty Campbell violated the Executive Branch Code of Ethics codified at KRS 11A.020(1)(a) and (b);

WHEREAS, Liberty Campbell was at all relevant times mentioned in the Initiating Order a “public servant” as defined in KRS 11A.010(9) and thus subject to the Executive Branch Code of Ethics; and

WHEREAS, Liberty Campbell indicates her desire to resolve all issues in this action by the execution of a Settlement Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, in settlement of the above allegations, the Commission and Liberty Campbell agree, pursuant to KRS 11A.100, as follows:

1. Liberty Campbell admits that she committed violations of the Executive Branch Code of Ethics codified at KRS 11A.020(1)(a) and (b), as stated in Appendix A to the Commission’s Initiating Order of September 15, 2014, attached hereto and incorporated by reference herein.

2. Liberty Campbell agrees to pay the Commission a civil penalty of one thousand five hundred (\$1,500.00) to be paid in full on or about November 7, 2014, in accordance with an Agreed Final Order.

3. Liberty Campbell agrees that upon the entry of the Agreed Final Order being issued by the Commission that she waives all rights to any further administrative process or appeal pursuant to KRS 13B.140 thereon.

4. The parties further agree that the acceptance of this Settlement Agreement by both parties, and the fulfillment of its express terms in the Agreed Final order, is in full accord and satisfaction of the herein referenced *Executive Branch Ethics Commission v. Liberty Campbell*, Agency Case No. 14-022.

5. This Settlement Agreement constitutes a public reprimand to Liberty Campbell, a copy of which will be provided to her former appointing authority, pursuant to KRS 11A.100(3)(c).
