AGREED FINAL ORDER

WHEREAS, the parties having reached a settlement in this matter, and the Executive Branch Ethics Commission being otherwise sufficiently advised,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND ADJUDGED as follows:

- 1. The executed Settlement Agreement, attached hereto as Exhibit A, is incorporated by reference as if fully stated herein.
- 2. Michael Schiesser shall pay the civil penalty in the total amount of three thousand dollars (\$3,000.00) by mailing a check or money order payable to the Kentucky State Treasurer so that it is received by the Executive Branch Ethics Commission within one year from the date that he is released from incarceration with the Commonwealth of Kentucky.
- 3. If Michael Schiesser fails to make payment in full in the method described in Paragraph 2 above, then the Executive Branch Ethics Commission may immediately file an enforcement action in Franklin Circuit Court for the

unpaid balance of the civil penalty, plus twelve percent (12%) per annum from the date of default, until the civil penalty is paid in full, as well as any expenses and attorney's fees associated with collecting the penalty.

Upon full payment of the civil penalty, this case shall be dismissed as settled.
