FRANKFORT, KY – At its January 18, 2023 meeting the Executive Branch Ethics Commission found Christi Struening of Nicholasville, Kentucky, in violation of KRS Chapter 11A, the Executive Branch Code of Ethics.

In a Final Order of Default, the Commission found Ms. Struening violated the Code of Ethics in two (2) separate counts. Specifically, Ms. Struening used her position as a nurse aide to obtain personal checks in the amount of \$800.00 and \$650.00 from a resident/patient of her place of employment.

Pursuant to the Final Order of Default, Ms. Struening must pay a \$10,000.00 civil penalty and receive a public reprimand.
