EXECUTIVE BRANCH ETHICS COMMISSION
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FRANKFORT, KY – Today, the Executive Branch Ethics Commission found JEREMY RIGGS of Bardstown, Kentucky, in violation of KRS Chapter 11A, the Executive Branch Code of Ethics.

In a Settlement Agreement approved by the Commission, Mr. Riggs agreed not to contest two counts of violating the Code of Ethics. Specifically, on two separate occasions, Mr. Riggs entered into an agreement, through his personal, for-profit business Back 9 Productions, to provide videography services to the Department of Parks, an agency of the Cabinet where Riggs currently works. Mr. Riggs entered these agreements after being expressly directed in writing to “not have any contracts between your private business and any agency of the Tourism, Arts, and Heritage Cabinet.”

Pursuant to the Settlement Agreement, Mr. Riggs agreed to pay a \$2,000.00 civil penalty, receive a public reprimand, and waives any right to appeal. The Commission concluded the matter by issuing an Agreed Final Order.
