FRANKFORT, KY – At its September 21, 2022 meeting the Executive Branch Ethics Commission found MICHAEL WILLIAMS of La Grange, Kentucky, in violation of KRS Chapter 11A, the Executive Branch Code of Ethics.

In a Settlement Agreement approved by the Commission, Mr. Williams admitted to one (1) count of violating the Code of Ethics. Specifically, Mr. Williams used a state issued cell phone for non-work prurient interests.

Pursuant to the Settlement Agreement, Mr. Williams must pay a \$2,000.00 civil penalty and receive a public reprimand. The Commission concluded the matter by issuing an Agreed Final Order.
