FRANKFORT, KY – At its May 15, 2024, meeting the Executive Branch Ethics Commission found Wayne Howel Carr of Mayfield, Kentucky, in violation of KRS Chapter 11A, the Executive Branch Code of Ethics.

In a Settlement Agreement approved by the Commission, Wayne Howel Carr admitted to one (1) count of violating the Executive Branch Code of Ethics. Specifically, while employed as the Graves County Public Valuation Administrator (“PVA”), Department of Revenue, Wayne Howel Carr made prohibited and unsupported disbursements of PVA funds and resources that created privileges and financial gain for himself and others in derogation of the public interest at large.

Pursuant to the Settlement Agreement, Wayne Howel Carr agreed to pay a \$5,000.00 civil penalty. He also agreed to a public reprimand and waived any right to appeal. The Commission concluded the matter by issuing an Agreed Final Order.
