FRANKFORT, KY – At its November 17, 2022 meeting the Executive Branch Ethics Commission found Matthew Adam Humphrey of Dixon, Kentucky, in violation of KRS Chapter 11A, the Executive Branch Code of Ethics.

In a Settlement Agreement approved by the Commission, Mr. Humphrey acknowledged three (3) counts of violating the Code of Ethics. Specifically, while Mr. Humphrey served as supervisor of the Construction Branch, a business with connections to his family was awarded construction contracts directly overseen by the Construction Branch, he was advised by his supervisor to refrain from being involved in projects involving the business but continued to play an active role in those matters, and continued to be involved in possible future contracts.

Pursuant to the Settlement Agreement, Mr. Humphrey must pay a \$6,000.00 civil penalty and receive a public reprimand. The Commission concluded the matter by issuing an Agreed Final Order.
