



COMMONWEALTH OF KENTUCKY
EXECUTIVE BRANCH ETHICS COMMISSION

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FRANKFORT, KY – At its November 16, 2023 meeting, the Executive Branch Ethics Commission found Lori Scholl of Gilbertsville, Kentucky, in violation of KRS Chapter 11A, the Executive Branch Code of Ethics.

In a Settlement Agreement approved by the Commission, Ms. Scholl admitted to one (1) count of violating the Code of Ethics. Specifically, while employed as a Server with the Department of Parks, Ms. Scholl used state time and/or resources to participate in the taking of a cell phone which belonged to a fellow employee.

Pursuant to the Settlement Agreement, Ms. Scholl agreed to pay a \$1,000.00 civil penalty. She also agreed to a public reprimand and waived any right to appeal. The Commission concluded the matter by issuing an Agreed Final Order.
