## **EXECUTIVE BRANCH ETHICS COMMISSION**

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FRANKFORT, KY – At its May 14, 2025 meeting, the Executive Branch Ethics Commission ("the Commission") found Chad L. Cairo, Danville, Kentucky, in violation of KRS Chapter 11A, the Executive Branch Code of Ethics.

In a Settlement Agreement, approved by the Commission, Chad L. Cairo admitted to violating one (1) count of the Code of Ethics, KRS 11A.020(1)(a)(c) and (d). Specifically, while employed as a Correctional Officer, Northpoint Training Center, Justice and Public Safety Cabinet, Mr. Cairo brought liquid methamphetamine for the purpose of trafficking into the facility.

Pursuant to the Settlement Agreement, Chad L. Cairo agreed to pay a \$1,500.00 civil penalty, receive a public reprimand, and waive any right to appeal. The Commission concluded the matter by issuing an Agreed Final Order.
