FRANKFORT, KY – Today, the Executive Branch Ethics Commission found ERIC MCKEE of Lawrenceburg, Kentucky, in violation of KRS Chapter 11A, the Executive Branch Code of Ethics.

In a Final Order of Default, the Commission found Mr. McKee to have violated three (3) counts in violation of the Code of Ethics. Specifically, during May, June, and July of 2019, Mr. Mckee improperly processed 403 rebuilt title applications for applicants. The applications were not properly logged into the One Stop Shop, which allowed the applications to bypass the One Stop Shop policy of having only one application processed per person, per day.

Pursuant to the Final Order of Default, Mr. McKee must pay a \$3,000.00 civil penalty and receive a public reprimand.
