FRANKFORT, KY – At its March 14, 2024 meeting the Executive Branch Ethics Commission found Jeffery Taylor of Hopkinsville, Kentucky, in violation of KRS Chapter 11A, the Executive Branch Code of Ethics.

In a Final Order of Default, the Commission found Mr. Taylor violated the Code of Ethics, KRS 11A.050 (1)(c) by failing to file his Statement of Financial Disclosure upon leaving his position as an officer with the state.

Pursuant to the Final Order of Default, Mr. Taylor must pay a \$5,000.00 civil penalty, file a Statement of Financial Disclosure for the period of January 1, 2022 to May 25, 2022. and receive a public reprimand.
