FRANKFORT, KY – Today, the Executive Branch Ethics Commission found LINDSAY BLEVINS of Bedford, Kentucky, in violation of KRS Chapter 11A, the Executive Branch Code of Ethics.

In a Settlement Agreement approved by the Commission, Ms. Blevins admitted to three (3) counts of violating the Code of Ethics. Specifically, from June through August of 2020, Blevins engaged in an inappropriate relationship with an inmate through the Department of Corrections' JPay system.

Pursuant to the Settlement Agreement, Ms. Blevins paid a \$3,000 civil penalty. The Commission concluded the matter by issuing a Final Order.
