FRANKFORT, KY – At its September 17, 2025 meeting, the Executive Branch Ethics Commission (“the Commission”) found Neil A. Moorman formerly of Erlanger, Kentucky, in violation of KRS Chapter 11A, the Executive Branch Code of Ethics.

In a Final Order of Default, the Commission found Neil A. Moorman violated the Code of Ethics, KRS 11A.020(1)(a) and (d). Specifically, on May 21, 2023, Neil A. Moorman Correctional Officer, Justice and Public Safety Cabinet, engaged in inappropriate physical contact with an incarcerated juvenile under his supervision at Campbell Juvenile Detention Center during work hours. In doing so, Mr. Moorman created a conflict between his personal interest and his public duties. Additionally, Mr. Moorman used his official position to create advantages for himself, in derogation of the public interest at large.

Pursuant to the Final Order of Default, Neil A. Moorman must pay a \$5,000.00 civil penalty, receive a public reprimand.
