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FRANKFORT, KY – At its May 15, 2024 meeting, the Executive Branch Ethics Commission found Rebecca Pittman of Campbellsville, Kentucky, in violation of KRS Chapter 11A, the Executive Branch Code of Ethics.

In a Settlement Agreement approved by the Commission, Rebecca Pittman admitted to two (2) counts of violating the Executive Branch Code of Ethics. Specifically, while employed as a Youth Worker at Adair Youth Development Center, Department of Juvenile Justice, Rebecca Pittman formed an inappropriate relationship with a juvenile under her supervision.

Pursuant to the Settlement Agreement, Rebecca Pittman agreed to pay a \$2,000.00 civil penalty. She also agreed to a public reprimand and waived any right to appeal. The Commission concluded the matter by issuing an Agreed Final Order.
