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FRANKFORT, KY – At its March 18, 2026 meeting, the Executive Branch Ethics Commission (“the Commission”) found Stefanie E. Mundhenk of Harrodsburg, Kentucky, in violation of KRS Chapter 11A, the Executive Branch Code of Ethics.

In a Settlement Agreement, approved by the Commission, Stefanie E. Mundhenk admitted to two (2) counts of violating the Executive Branch Code of Ethics, KRS 11A.020(1)(a) and (d) and 9 KAR 1:025 Sec 2(5). Specifically, Stefanie E. Mundhenk while employed as an attorney, Kentucky Department of Public Advocacy, Justice and Public Safety Cabinet, engaged in prohibited conduct of using state equipment, namely a state-issued mobile phone, for her personal interests.

Pursuant to the Settlement Agreement, Stefanie E. Mundhenk agreed to pay a \$2,000.00 civil penalty, receive a public reprimand, and waive any right to appeal. The Commission concluded the matter by adopting an Agreed Final Order.
