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FRANKFORT, KY – At its July 15, 2026, meeting, the Executive Branch Ethics Commission (“the Commission”) found Todd S. Boyce of Mt. Sterling, Kentucky, in violation of KRS Chapter 11A, the Executive Branch Code of Ethics.

In a Settlement Agreement approved by the Commission, Todd S. Boyce admitted to two (2) counts in violation of the Code of Ethics, KRS 11A.020(1)(a) and (d). Specifically, while employed as a Chaplain at Eastern Kentucky Correctional Complex, Department of Corrections, Justice and Public Safety Cabinet, Boyce used state resources namely a state computer to view and download naked pictures of men on his Facebook account. In addition, he also used a state computer to access an inmate’s Facebook account in his office at the prison.

Pursuant to the Settlement Agreement, Todd S. Boyce agreed to pay a \$ 2,000.00 civil penalty and receive a public reprimand and waive any right to appeal. The Commission concluded the matter by issuing an Agreed Final Order.

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
