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FRANKFORT, KY – At its January 15, 2025 meeting, the Executive Branch Ethics Commission found Tyler Beagle, Somerset, Kentucky, in violation of KRS Chapter 11A, the Executive Branch Code of Ethics.

In a Final Order of Default, the Commission found Tyler Beagle violated one (1) count of the Code of Ethics. Specifically, while serving as a Correctional Officer within the Justice and Public Safety Cabinet, Tyler Beagle used state resources to send unsolicited pictures of his genitalia to another person.

Pursuant to the Final Order of Default, Tyler Beagle must pay a \$5,000.00 civil penalty and receive a public reprimand.
