FRANKFORT, KY – At its January 21, 2026 meeting, the Executive Branch Ethics Commission (“the Commission”) found Dawn M. Driskell of Louisville, Kentucky, in violation of KRS Chapter 11A, the Executive Branch Code of Ethics.

In a Final Order of Default, the Commission found Dawn M. Driskell violated the Code of Ethics, KRS 11A.050(1)(c). Specifically, Dawn M. Driskell, an officer as defined under 11A.010(7), left her position as the Vice President of Finance, Kentucky Center for the Arts, Kentucky Tourism, Arts and Heritage Cabinet, and failed to file a Statement of Financial Disclosure as required.

Pursuant to Final Order of Default, Dawn M. Driskell must pay a \$5,000.00 civil penalty and receive a public reprimand.
